About the Course

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

- Have the physical capacity to complete the practical requirements of the course.

Part 1:

You are required to complete pre-course reading and a series of self-assessment questions. Required reading materials will be distributed prior to the training session.

Part 2:

You are required to attend for a half day training session. The session will include trainer led presentation, trainer practical skill demonstrations, and an opportunity for you to practice these skills in a simulated environment with trainers coaching and supervising the session.

Assessment:

A range of assessment methods are used throughout the course including written tests and practical skill demonstrations. You will receive detailed assessment information on commencement of the course.

Course Requirements:

There are no specialist clothing, equipment, or material requirements for this course.

Credit Transfer and Recognition of Prior Learning

Credit Transfer (CT) is the recognition by a registered training organisation (Parade College) of the qualifications, certificates and/or statements of attainment issued by other registered training organisations, universities and TAFEs.
