Epipen Expiry Dates - September/October 2022

Parents of anaphylactic students are asked to check the expiry dates of your son's Epipen. Students must commence the new Term with an in-date Epipen.

Epipens and Excursions

In order for a student to attend an excursion or event away from College premises they must carry their individual College Epipen and their spare Epipen from home with them. This is to ensure that sufficient medications are available should the student require them.

Students without both Epipens are unable to attend the excursion/event and must remain at the College.

Safety at Drop Off and Pickup

Our neighbours at Villa Maria have contacted us to note that there are a large number of Parade Students being dropped off, or collected, using their driveway off Plenty Road.

Of significant concern is that patient transfer ambulances are made to wait in a queue of cars in the morning when they are collecting patients, and again in the afternoon when they are dropping patients back to the Villa Maria Reception, as the driveway isn't wide enough for the ambulances to get past the line of cars there to drop off or collect students.

We ask that parents and carers please refrain from using this driveway to drop off or collect students.

2023 JacPLUS - Jacaranda e-Textbook Bundle for Years 8 to 10 in 2023

In 2023, Parade College will continue to use Jacaranda's \$115 Digital Bundle as its digital textbook and educational resource provider for students in Years 7 to 10.

Parents should have received a letter on 26 September, to coincide with the opening of the payment portal.

To ensure that you receive your son's 2023 school year text books and resources, you are asked to order and pay the \$115 fee online via Jacaranda's payment portal by 29 October 2022.

Year 10 Edmund Rice Pathways Program (ERPP) students at Preston in 2023 are not required to purchase the Jacaranda Bundle.

VCAA VCE and VET Unit 3/4 Written Examinations

The first written exam for most students is English on Wednesday 26 October, although Language Oral and Music Performance examinations are commencing on 3 October.

Minor language exams also precede the English examination; students involved should carefully check their timetables.

Each student will also be issued with the VCAA Exam Navigator which contains all rules and regulations regarding the exam period.

It is very important for every student to make the most of the final preparation time that is just ahead of them. The first few weeks of Term 4 consist of formal revision classes followed by informal revision (17 October until the scheduled exam dates) with Year 12 teachers available during regular timetabled class times up to the date of their respective exam.

In many subjects, 50% of the marks for the year are allocated from the exam score so it is vital to keep looking ahead and for each student to be reaching an academic peak come exam time.

Accelerating Year 11 students will continue to attend classes until the date of the respective VCAA examinations.

Year 8, 9, 10 and 11 Semester 2 Examinations

Semester 2 examinations will commence in early November; dates and details provided below.

During the examination period, Year 10 and 11 students are not required to attend school other than for scheduled examinations. Supervised revision will be arranged for those attending school.

Year 8 and 9 students attend as normal. All students are encouraged to allocate time from now, not only for homework but also for revising for the semester examinations. Your sons will receive extensive revision materials to assist in their preparations.

Year 11: 2 to 11 November Year 10: 3 to 11 November Year 9: 15 to 17November Year 8: 14 to 17 November
